

Post-Effective Date Procedures for Serving “Court Papers”

As set forth in Section 17.16 of Delta’s Confirmed Plan of Reorganization, except as otherwise provided in the Plan, the Case Management Order shall remain in full force and effect, and all “Court Papers” (as defined in the Case Management Order) shall be filed and served in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Case Management Order; *provided* that on and after the Effective Date, “Court Papers” (as defined in the Case Management Order) need only be served on (i) the chambers of the Honorable Adlai S. Hardin, Jr., 300 Quarropas Street, Room 530, White Plains, NY 10601, (ii) the attorneys for the Debtors, Davis Polk & Wardwell, 450 Lexington Avenue, New York, NY 10017, Attn: Marshall S. Huebner, Esq., (iii) aircraft counsel to the Debtors, Debevoise & Plimpton LLP, 919 Third Avenue, New York, NY 10022, Attn: Richard F. Hahn, Esq., (iv) Bankruptcy Services, LLC, 757 Third Avenue, New York, NY 10011, Attn: Robert Saraceni and (v) with respect to those matters within the purview of the Post-Effective Date Committee as set forth in Section 17.5 of the Plan, counsel to the Post-Effective Date Committee, Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, 590 Madison Avenue, 20th Floor, New York, NY 10022, Attn: Daniel H. Golden, Lisa G. Beckerman, David H. Botter; *provided, further* that final requests for payment of Professional Fee Claims filed pursuant to Section 8.1(a) of the Plan (and all “Court Papers” related thereto) shall also be served on the Office of the United States Trustee for the Southern District of New York, 33 Whitehall Street, Suite 2100, New York, NY 10004, Attn: Greg M. Zipes, Esq.
